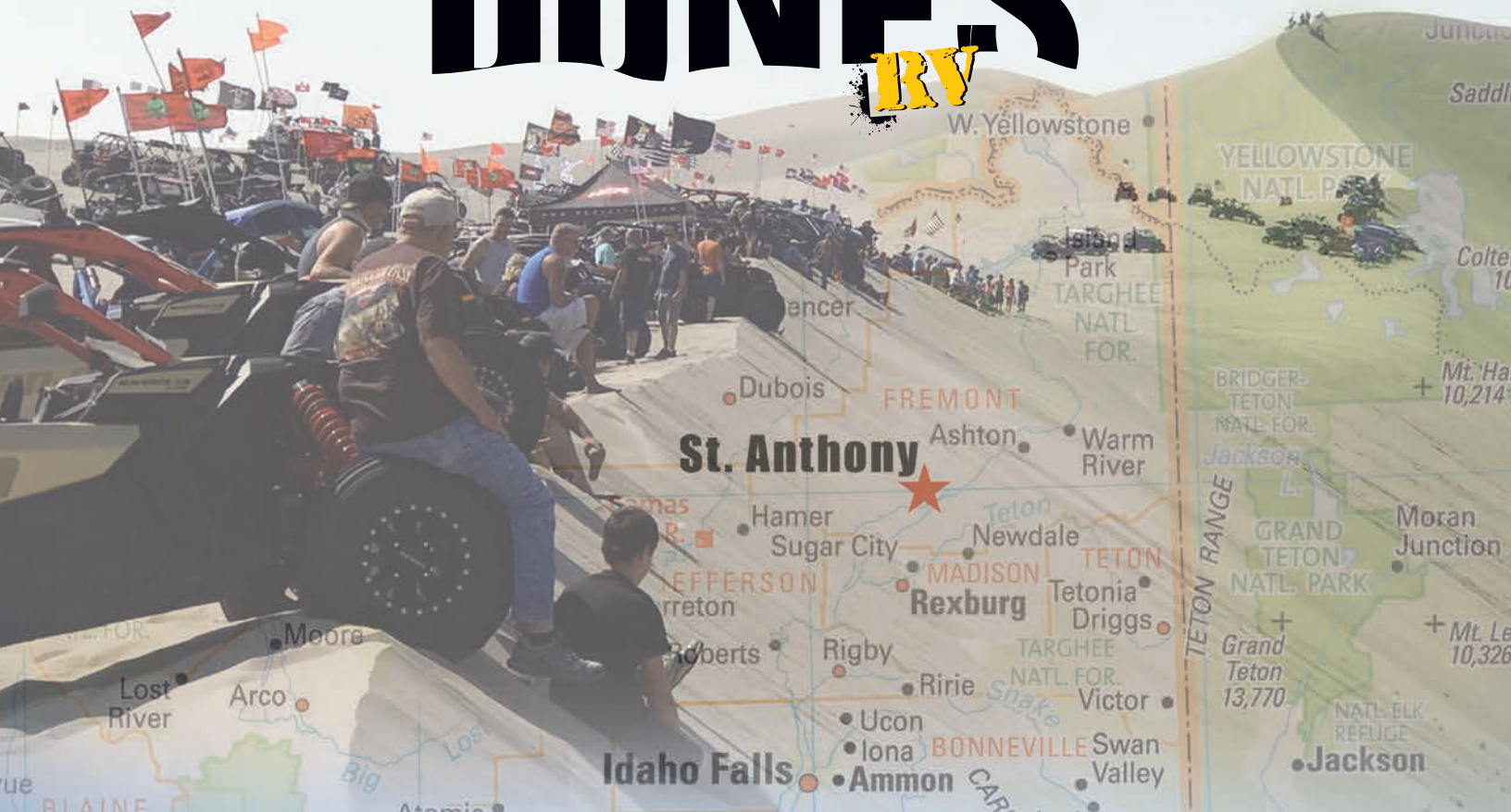

DAY 1



Congratulations! You have endured the drive from home and now it's time to relax and find out for yourself what the hype is all about.

Itinerary:
1:00 PM – Check in at Idaho Dunes RV and get your camp site set up and toys unloaded.
3:00 PM – Venture out into the dunes for your first taste of the sand. We recommend taking the drive over to Egin Lake with a stop at Thunder Mountain. Get the lay of the land between Idaho Dunes RV and the lake, as you will make this trip several more times during your stay. The Idaho Dunes RV entrance is marked with an American Flag that can be seen on the horizon when returning back to camp. The blue and white Parker water tower is the best point of refence from the dunes to get your bearings as to where camp is located.

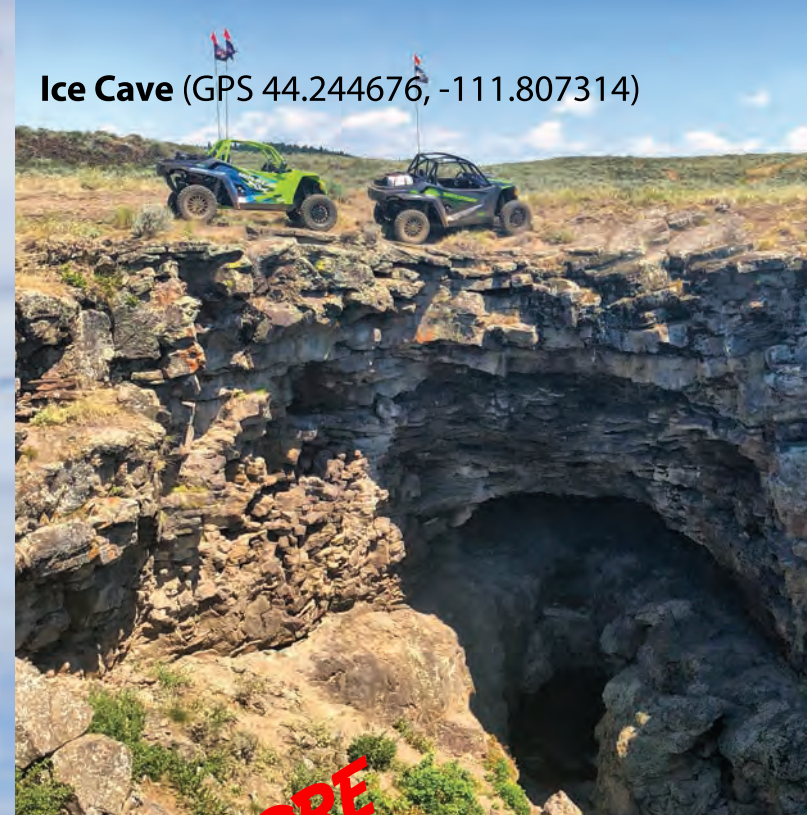
Now that you are comfortable with your surroundings, let's get out there and run wide open throttle!

**FREE RIDE!**

To accommodate the family, this is a great day to dune to Egin Lake and set up a base camp. Many duners bring out shade canopies, BBQ's, chairs and coolers. The die-hard duners can make runs from the lake, while those looking for a bit of relaxation can dip their toes in the water and hang out on the beach.



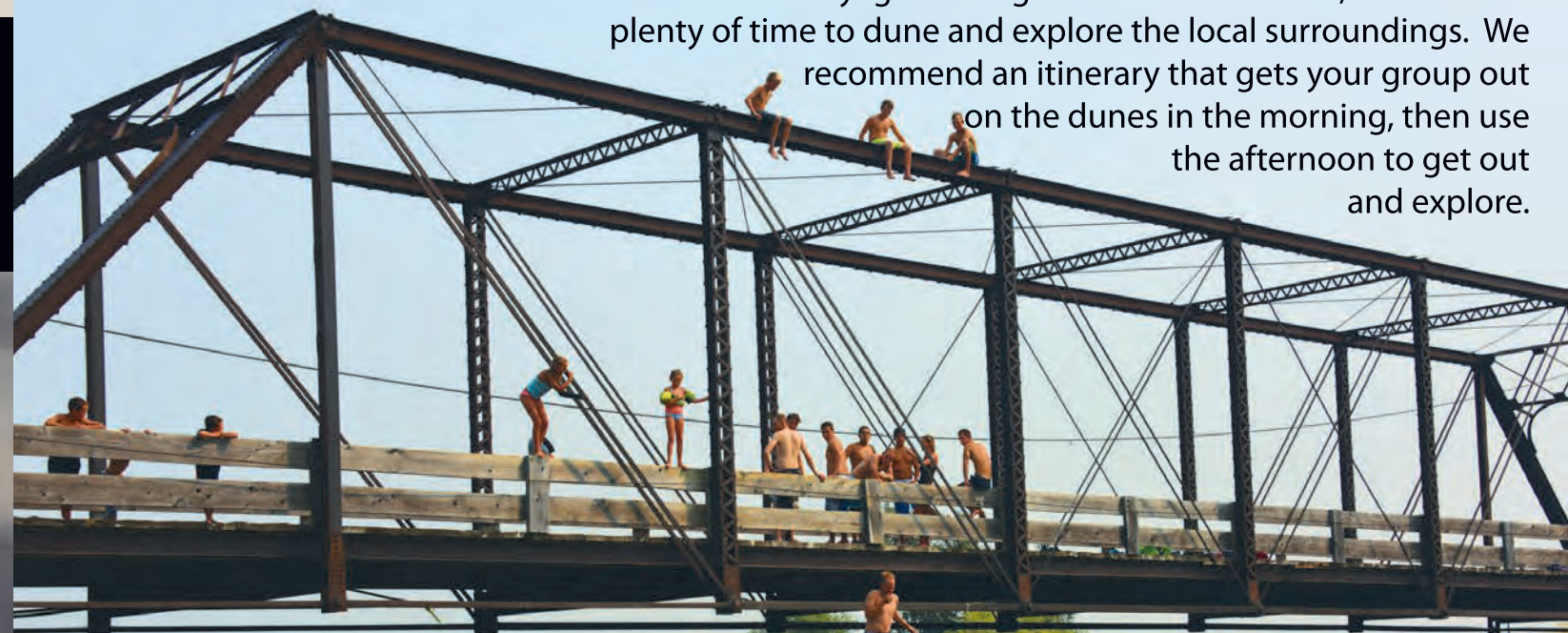

**EXPLORE** *St. Anthony, Idaho*

With over 15 hours of daylight during the summer months, Idaho offers plenty of time to dune and explore the local surroundings. We recommend an itinerary that gets your group out on the dunes in the morning, then use the afternoon to get out and explore.

**Itinerary:**

9:00 AM: Dune Ride

1:00 PM: Civil Defense and Ice Cave Exploration

What to bring: Flashlights, Sturdy Shoes, Light Jacket

4:00 PM: Fun Farm Bridge Swimming Hole and Bridge Jumping

What to bring: Water shoes, Swimsuit, Beach Towel

Jackson Hole or Bust!

Today we will take a quick trip over the Teton Mountain Range and visit historic Jackson, Wyoming. Jackson has an incredible downtown area that includes great shopping, dining and souvenir hunting opportunities. In addition to experiencing the local culture, it's highly recommended that your group take some time to white water raft the Snake River, then get some entertainment and grub at a chuckwagon dinner show.

Itinerary:

9:00 AM: Depart Camp for Jackson, Wyoming

11:00 AM: White Water Rafting w/ Mad River Boat Trips

What to bring: Water shoes or tennis shoes that can get wet, swimsuit, towel, waterproof dry bag or ziplock bag for phones and cameras, GoPro head mount recommended.

2:00 PM: Explore Downtown Jackson on foot. Be sure to visit the Million Dollar Cowboy Bar and walk the Town Square

What to bring: Camera, light jacket, sunscreen, mosquito spray

Today will be a great day to relax, get back in the dunes and take a scenic, self-guided float down Warm River in Ashton. After your float, stop into Ashton to experience the 1 Pound Burger at Big Jud's as seen on Man vs. Food.

Itinerary:

9:00 AM: Dune Ride

2:00 PM: Depart camp for Ashton's Warm River.

What to bring: 2 vehicles will be needed to shuttle people between the Put-in and Take-out locations. River float tube, water shoes or tennis shoes that can get wet, swimsuit, towel, waterproof dry bag or ziplock bag for phones and cameras, GoPro head mount recommended.

6:00 PM: Grab some grub on your way back to camp at the world famous Big Jud's

Recommendation: Idaho Dunes RV recommends the Big Jud Special. This is a one-pound burger on a delicious homemade bun, fries or tots, 2 drinks and 2 ice cream cones.





Now that you have been exposed to our version of an Idaho High-Adventure vacation, today will not disappoint. Dunes, Bears, and Zip Lines... What more could you ask for in a single day? After your morning dune ride, we will be sending you to Yellowstone Bear World, just 15 minutes from camp. At Bear World you will experience a drive through wildlife tour, where you will get up close and personal with bears, buffalo, elk and various other native animals. Be sure to ask about their bottle feeding bear cubs experience. From Bear World, we will be sending you directly to Heise Zip to enjoy some high wire aerial adventures. This 10-zipline course is fun for adults and kids of all ages.

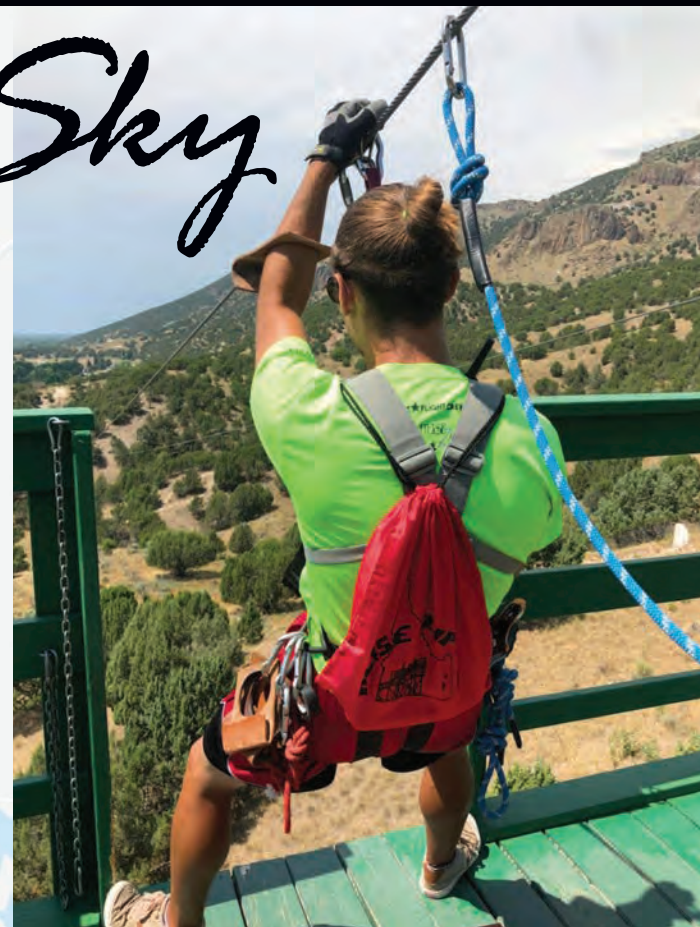

EXPLORE THE TRAILS

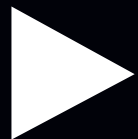


There are hundreds of miles of UTV/ATV trails that can be accessed directly from the Idaho Dunes RV campground! The following are some of the popular destinations:
